**Course Description:**

Leaders who are seeking to lead more to Jesus both need mentors and need to be mentors. In addition to providing a biblical framework for Christian mentoring, this course will provide practical mentoring skills and resources for application to the student's own life and leadership. Application will also be made to equip the student as a mentor to those they are leading and to those they are seeking to influence for the Gospel.

- In response to the book *Axiom*, develop 5 leadership axioms of your own. Create an under 10 minute powerpoint or keynote presentation to share with the class during the course. Please note that after the course, each student will receive a master CD that includes all presentations. Evaluation criteria will focus on content, creativity and clarity in communication. - In response to *Grown Up Digital*, identify and explain 7 principles that can inform Christian leaders in mentoring the Digital Generation. Submit in two pages. (to be completed prior to first day of class)
